

5TH JAPAN/KOREA HYDROGRAPHIC TECHNICAL MEETING HELD IN TONGHAE, REP. OF KOREA

27 - 28 OCTOBER 1993

The 5th Japan/Korea Hydrographic Technical Meeting was held at the Tonghae Branch, Republic of Korea Office of Hydrographic Affairs (ROKOHA) on 27 and 28 November 1993.
