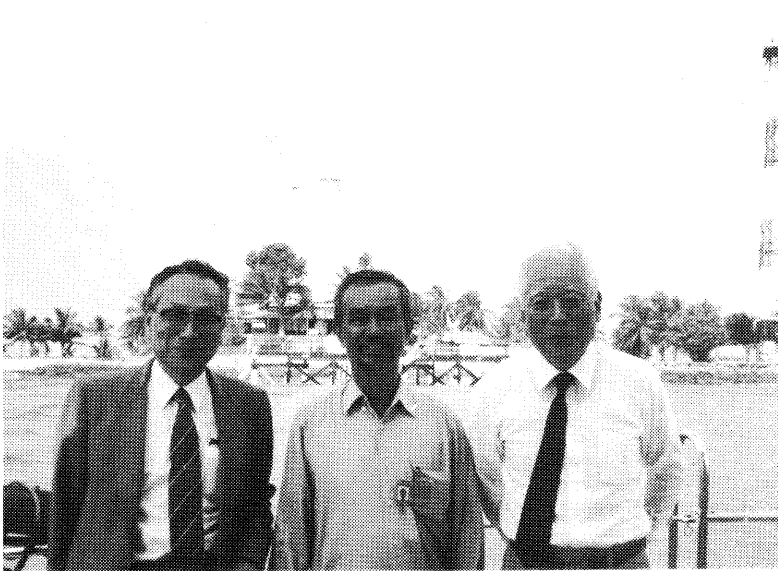


DR. IWABUCHI VISITS SINGAPORE AND MALAYSIA

Dr. Y. Iwabuchi, the then Chief Hydrographer of Japan, made an official trip to Singapore and Malaysia from 28 February to 5 March 1994.
