SEMINAR ON NAVIGATIONAL WARNINGS IN NAVAREA XI TO BE HELD IN TOKYO

Recalling the collision of two oil tankers, the Maersk Navigator and the Sanko Honor, at the west entrance of the Malacca Strait in January 1993, the Hydrographic Department of Japan is now planning, in support of Sasakawa Peace Foundation and the Japan Hydrographic Association, to hold a twoday seminar for exchange of information and views specially on the current situation of such warning services in East Asian countries as well as for ensuring the effective and efficient navigational warning service in NAVAREA XI.

It is now being arranged by J.H.D. to host the seminar at the Hydrographic Department in Tokyo early in December this year, and an official invitation will be sent to nine countries concerned: People's Republic of China, Hong Kong, Indonesia, Republic of Korea, Malaysia, Philippines, Singapore, Thailand, and the United States.
