

JICA GROUP TRAINING COURSE IN HYDROGRAPHIC SURVEY, 1994, STARTS

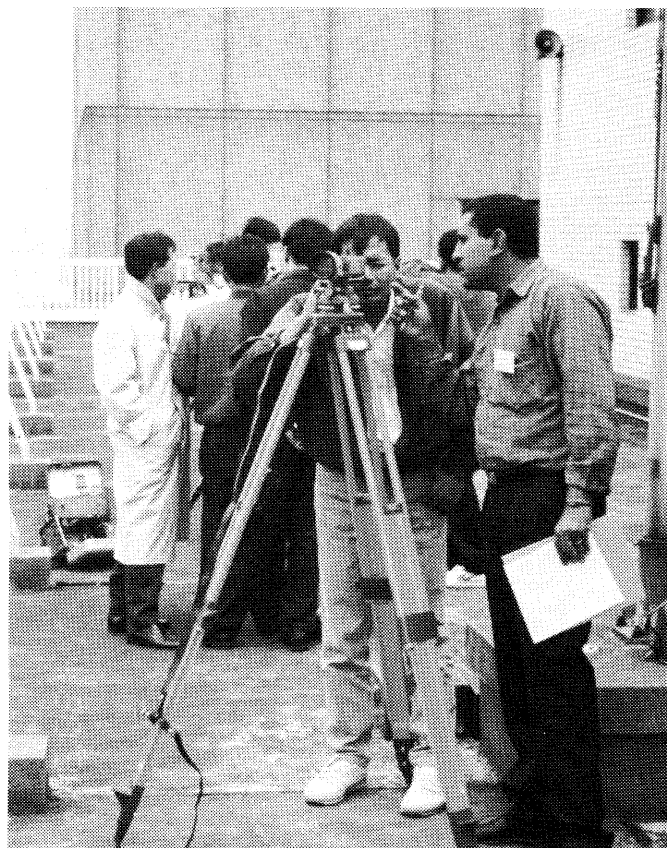
