

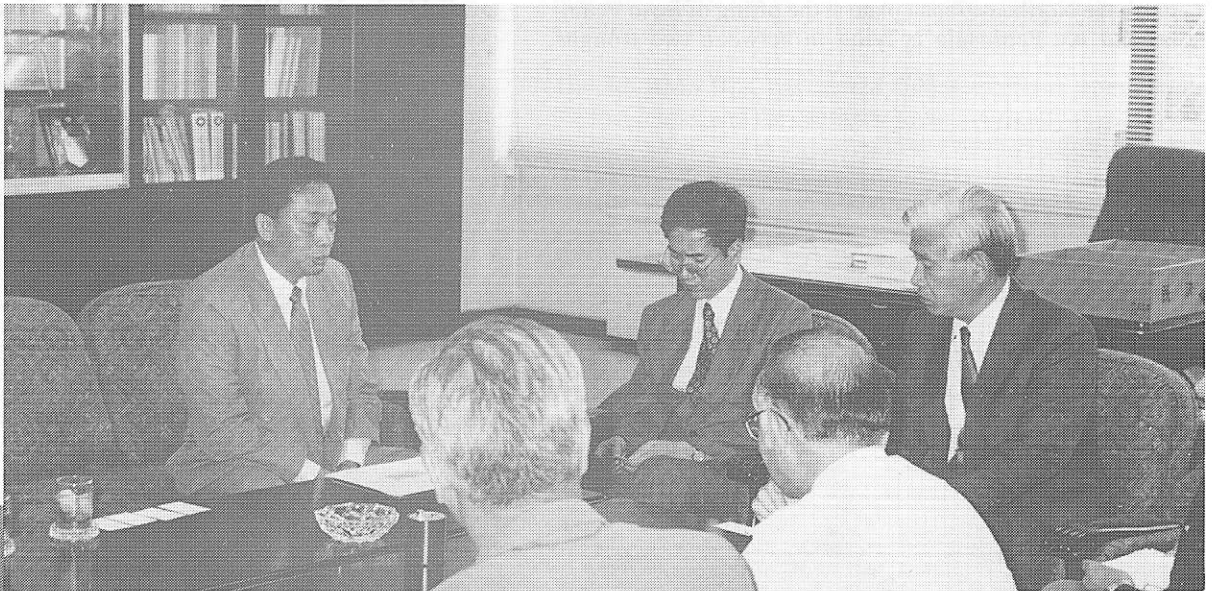
JAPANESE, PHILIPPINE HOS' TOPS MEET

Commodore Renato B. Feir, Director, Coast and Geodetic Survey Department, NAMRIA, Philippines, visited the Hydrographic Department of Japan in Tokyo and called on the Chief Hydrographer, Mr. Masaru Shiozaki, at his office room on 6 September 1994.

Discussion and exchange of views between two Hydrographers as well as J.H.D. staff present took place on various subjects, including a proposed project on bathymetric charting of Manila Bay, electronic charting, the forthcoming meeting of EAHC, South China Sea project, and other technical

cooperation programs.

After discussion at the Chief Hydrographer's room, Commodore Feir was shown, conducted by Mr. Tadao Tatsuno, Head of Cartography Office, the ENC compilation and production system of J.H.D., which started its operation in January 1994.
