The Indonesian Naval Hydrographic School (NHS) is under direction of Naval Education Command, yet its activities being under coordination and full support of Indonesian Naval Hydro-Oceanographic Service (DISHIDROS).

NHS conducts training courses for officers and for petty officers in order to provide Hydro-Oceanographic Service with qualified and good skill of hydrographic and oceanographic field surveyors. These courses are not only applicable for navy personnel but also open for those from various institutions which are interested in marine environment.

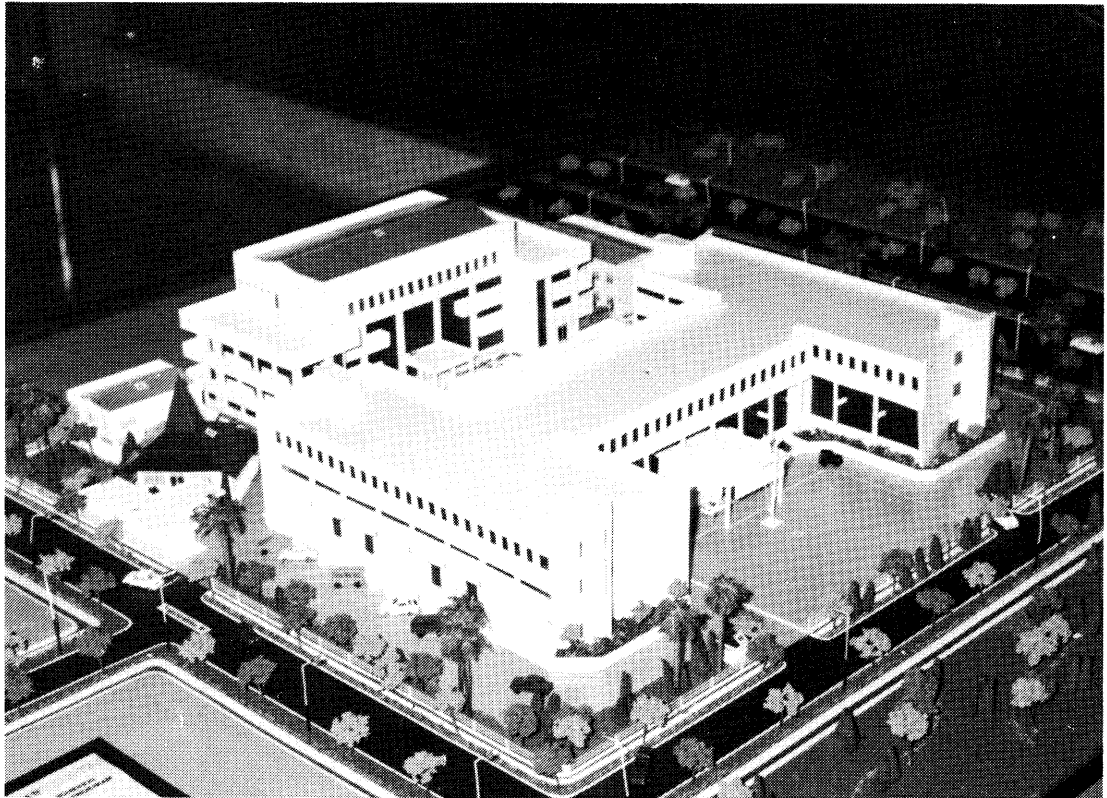
NHS was officially opened in 1963, attached to Hydro-Oceanographic Service, located in Jakarta, and since 1963

NHS has graduated 406 students.

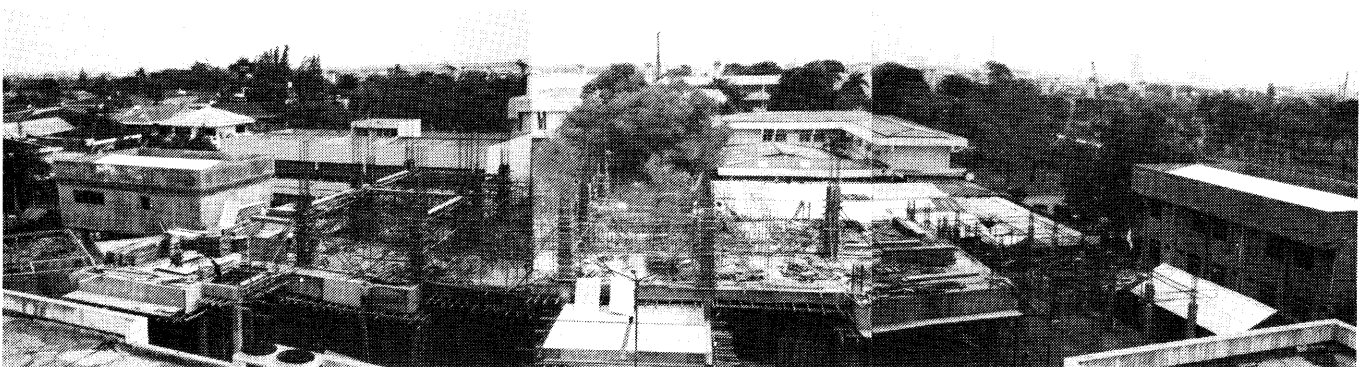
