
New Director General of OHA, Republic of Korea

Mr. KIM, Kwon Soo assumed the post of Director General of the Office of Hydrographic Affairs (OHA), Ministry of Construction and Transportation, Republic of Korea on 27 March 1996.

Mr. Kim, age 57, graduated from Seoul National University in 1962, and Graduate School of Public Administration, Seoul National University in 1971. Then he joined the Ministry of Transportation (MOT). He had served at various important posts in the ministry such as in Tourism Bureau and Director of Taxi Division of Land Transport Bureau as well as Director of General Affairs Division of OHA from 1990 to 91, and Director of Regional Transport Division of the Ministry of Construction and Transportation from 1995 until he was appointed as Director General of OHA.

New Chief Hydrographer of Indonesia

First Admiral NICOLAS P. ELLO of the Indonesian Navy took over the post of Chief Hydrographer of Indonesia on 1 April 1996.

He was born on 27 September 1944 and graduated from Naval Academy in 1970. In 1976 attended Foreign Officers - ASW Course in San Diego, U. S. A. In 1978, he specialized in hydrography upon completion of Hydrographic Course. He also attended Hydrographic and Oceanographic Courses in Japan in 1980/1981, and then served on various surveying ships.

He commanded the survey ship KRI Jalanidhi in 1986 and after completion of the Naval Command and Staff College in 1988 he commanded the survey ship KRI Dewa Kembar (former HMS Hydra).

He served in several leading positions such as Head of Survey Division, Commander of Hydrographic Vessels and Survey Unit, Head of Marine Environment Division for the period from 1 June 1994 to 15 December 1994.

He became Project Officer of Fisheries Exploration and Oceanographic Research Ship Baruna Jaya IV, in France. He was promoted to Deputy Hydrographer on 2 January 1996, and was assumed Chief Hydrographer on 1 April 1996.
