OBSERVATION/STUDY TOUR TO TOKATIBUTO LORAN-C STATION, HOKKAIDO

The Observation/Study Tour to Tokatibuto LORAN-C Station (LC) for the participants of the Group Training Course in Hydrographic Survey for 1996 was conducted from 30 October to 1 November.

The participants flew from Tokyo to Obihiro-City, Hokkaido, on 30 October. It was very warm with the temperature higher than 20 degrees Centigrade in whole Japan in that season, but it was very cold on 31st for the participants, only 5 degree Centigrade in Obihiro-City when they visited the Tokatibuto LC.

The Tokatibuto LC is a LC constituted Northwest Pacific Chain and Russia Chain of a part of Far East Area LORAN C Chains, which are constituted under cooperation of four nations: China, Korea, Russia and Japan, with 6 chains by 16 LC.

After visiting the Tokatibuto LC the participants observed at the Tokati River where many swans came migrated from Russia, and also some shoals of salmon fish sailed up the river for laying eggs.
