Individual training in hydrography conducted at JHD

An individual training in hydrographic surveying was conducted for three persons of Indonesia, Malaysia, and Singapore by the Hydrographic Department of Japan under the counterpart training scheme of the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA).

Mr. Masjhuri, Directorate General of Sea Communications of Indonesia, Mr. Mohd. Nazam Bin Sulaiman, Marine Department of Peninsular Malaysia, and Mr. Jamie Chen Yin Kiat, Hydrographic Department, Maritime & Port Authority of Singapore, were accepted at JHD from 10 February to 3 March 1997 for training of counterparts participating in the JICA project of the resurvey of Malacca and Singapore Straits, which is now being carried out jointly by the three littoral countries and Japan.
