First Admiral T.H. Soesetyo was appointed as a new Indonesian Chief Hydrographer. He has substituted First Admiral I Nyoman Arinu S. on 21st August 2002. He was born in Semarang, Central Java on 5th August 1954. He has joined in Indonesian Navy from Indonesian Naval Academy in 1976 and had completed his qualification at the Armed Forces Staff and Command College Course XXV in 1997.

Soesetyo has had the following several military education, 3–M Systems Course in 1981, OBA Cadre Training Course in 1981, Tactical Procedure Course in 1982, Hydroraphic Officer Course in 1982, Cours De Hydrographique Et Oceanographique Pratique in 1984, Officer Secondary Course III in 1985, and Naval Staff and Command College Course XXXI in 1993.
