(1) Training Course on Planning and Management of ENC

The JICA Country Focused Training Course on Planning and Management of Electronic Navigational Charts (ENC) for the Republic of the Philippines for 2004 was carried out at the Japan Hydrographic and Oceanographic Department (JHOD) in Tokyo, on March 1-16, 2004. The course objective was to learn Japanese hydrographic survey data collection system as well as practical training of ENC to plan, to manage and to update. Mr. Rodolfo M.
