

Tokyo Training Course/Seminar on the UNCLOS Continental Shelf Survey

Training Course/Seminar on the UNCLOS Continental Shelf Survey was carried out at the Hydrographic and Oceanographic Department (HOD) of Japan, Tokyo, from 15 - 18 March 2005. Nine trainees and four lectures from abroad and several lecturers from Japan were invited. DOALOS Training Manual was used for basic design of training portion. Trainees were provided with basic knowledge on UNCLOS and S/T Guideline, surveys and discussed about issues on islands, ridges, and active margins.
