

THE 16TH JAPAN/KOREA HYDROGRAPHIC TECHNICAL MEETING

The 16th Japan/Korea Hydrographic Technical Meeting was held at the Hydrographic and Oceanographic Department of Japan (JHOD) in Tokyo on 23-24 March 2006. JHOD welcomed Mr. You-Sub JUNG, new Director General of National Oceanographic Research Institute, Ministry of Maritime Affairs and Fisheries and other 4 members.

First meeting was held on 1989 when Japanese Survey Vessel SHOYO visited the Port of Incheon, Republic of Korea. And the second meeting was held on 1990 when Korean Survey Vessel PUSAN 801 had visited the Port of Tokyo. Already the profitable meetings were based on mutual cooperation and close relationship between two organizations and held 16 times since 1989.
