## NAVTEX SERVICE PLAN in the D.P.R.K OF KOREA

In the D.P.R.of Korea, NAVTEX Service is planned to provide the MSI for the coastwise sailings of the ships in the territorial waters of the DPRK.

According to the requirement for the use of the Common Frequency 518kHz in the world, we are trying for the appropriate coverage area and transmit time to avoid the risk of mutual interference with the signals of the other stations which have been already installed and operated in the sea area around the korean peninsular.

Some planned details are as follows.

- Transmitting Power :1kw
- Transmitting Frequency:518kHz (English); 490kHz (Korean)
- Coverage area:120-200 n-mile from the coast.
- Service: Navigational Warnings.
