

JICA Country Focused Training Course in Management on Hydrographic Data and Maintenance of Equipment for the Republic of the Philippines for 2006

As part of technical cooperation for the Philippines, the JICA Country Focused Training Course in Management on Hydrographic Data and Maintenance of Equipment for the Republic of the Philippines for 2006 was carried out at the Hydrographic and Oceanographic Department of Japan, Tokyo, from 3 October to 1 December 2006.

The course objective is to have thorough knowledge of the function of narrow multibeam sounding system and digital chart editing system, and to understand proper survey planning and the data processing techniques. Furthermore, it is required to obtain the capability of seeking cause when the system malfunctions. Therefore, the following subjects were included in this course: onboard exercise using survey boat, field exercise using GPS and study tour as well as lectures for computer network, data compiling using GIS and so on.
