NAMRIA Administrator, USec. Diony A. Ventura has formally designated Captain Romeo I. Ho as the Acting Director of the Hydrography Department (HD), effective 26 February 2009. The brief ceremony, which was witnessed by HD officers and personnel, was held in the HD Board Room, NAMRIA Branch Office, Binondo Manila.

Captain Ho replaced Commodore Rodolfo M. Agaton who served as the department director for six years and has compulsorily retired from the service. Prior to his new appointment, Captain Ho was the HD Chief of Staff and, at the same time, the Chief of the HD Hydrographic Surveys Division. He started his career in August 1979 in the commissioned service in the former Bureau of Coast and Geodetic Survey under the Ministry of National Defense. When NAMRIA's newly acquired survey vessels arrived in Manila in 1998, Captain Ho was designated as the first commanding officer of the survey vessel BRP HYDROGRAPHER PRESBITERO.

The Administrator advised Captain Ho to look after the welfare of the department's officers and personnel, particularly the officers and personnel aboard the agency's two survey vessels.
