3RD INTERNATIONAL ECDIS CONFERENCE

Singapore, 19TH to 21ST October 2009





Introduction

The 3rd International ECDIS Conference and Exhibition (IEC) was jointly organised by the Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore (MPA) and the United Kingdom Hydrographic Office (UKHO). The Guest of Honour was Singapore's Senior Parliamentary Secretary, Mr Teo Ser Luck, Ministry Of Community Development, Youth and Sports & Ministry of Transport, Singapore. The conference was also graced by His Excellency, Mr Paul Madden, British High Commissioner to Singapore. The Conference was attended by about 300 participants from 31 countries.

ECDIS – Beyond Navigation

This objective of this conference was two fold, namely to better prepare ship owners of the impending mandatory ECDIS carriage requirements from 2012, and to promote the potential of ECDIS other than navigation. The 3 day event included 24 presentations under the following sessions:
