3rd COORDINATION MEETING

3rd Coordinating Meeting of Japan Capacity Building Project was held on 3 February 2010, at the Japan Hydrographic and Oceanographic Department, Tokyo, Japan. The representatives from Japan Hydrographic Association, Japan Hydrographic and Oceanographic Department, United Kingdom Hydrographic Office, and International Hydrographic Bureau were present.

Japan Capacity Building Project funded by the Nippon Foundation was established in order to train experts of nautical charting in developing countries.

The meeting evaluated the course conducted in 2009 and discussed contents and schedule of the training course which will be held from September to December 2010. In addition, it was agreed to establish an association of the graduates of the training course in order to share information and maintain their network.
