NEW MEMBER OF EAHC

NEW CHIEF HYDROGRAPHER OF KOREA

Mr. LEE Heon-Seek was appointed as Director General of the Office of Hydrographic Affairs, Ministry of Transportation, Republic of Korea, on 21 October 1987, relieving Dr. Mun-Son KIM. Born on 23 April 1947, he graduated the Seoul National University, and then studied Shipping Economics at the University of Wales in the United Kingdom. PHILIPPINE BCGS RENAMED

The Bureau of Coast and Geodetic Survey (BCGS) has been merged with three other agencies to form the National Mapping and Resource Information Authority (NAMRIA), Department of Environment and Natural Resources, and is now called the Surveys Department of NAMRIA.
